

WHAT IS PHAR?



The Philippine Humanitarian Assistance Registry (PHAR) is the primary government website for information, inquiries and procedures on all local and foreign humanitarian assistance to the Philippine Government, including in-kind and financial donations, and deployment of humanitarian workers for COVID-19 as well as other future pandemics and civil and natural disasters.

The PHAR is managed by an inter-agency team composed of the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), the Department of National Defense - Office of Civil Defense (DND-OCD) and the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA).

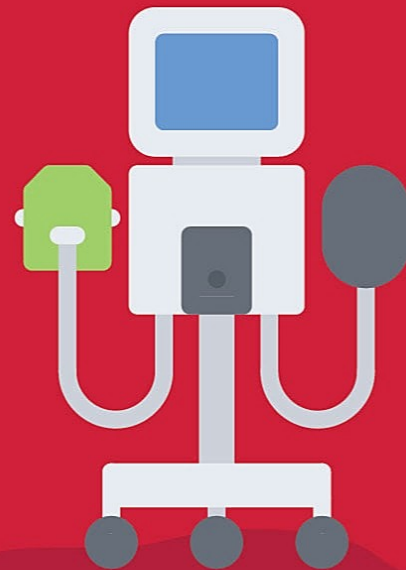

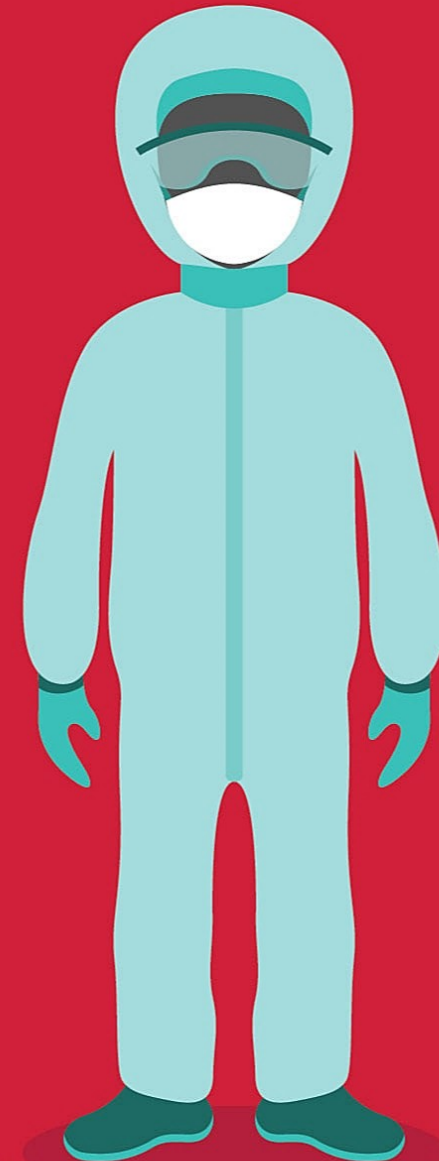
