This Office endorses the holding of the Webinar on Online Teaching Strategies to be sponsored by the United States Department of Education, US Embassy in Manila which will be hosted by the Angeles University Foundation, Angeles City and to be facilitated by Dr. Amy Burden of the University of Memphis, the Virtual English Language Fellow (VELF) assigned to AUF on 10 October 2020.

EL Fellows are assigned to Philippine host institutions to promote English language teaching and learning. A teacher education institution (TEI) may send at least three English language teachers to participate in this webinar.
