Opportunity 2.0, a program of the United States Agency for International Development (USAID), aims to improve the education, employment, and livelihood outcomes for the out-of-school youth across 12 identified cities in the Philippines until 2025. It is implemented by the Education Development Center (EDC), in collaboration with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Department of Education (DepEd), Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Local Government Units (LGUs), and partners in the private sector.
