The Commission on Higher Education Region III (CHEDRO-III) extends the celebration of the 2021 ASEAN Month through the implementation of the three (3) winning entries of the Padyak Goes Internationalization Through ASEAN (PaGITAN) Regional Competition held in August 2021 namely: Brand Building of Region III Towards Internationalization Growth Hubs in Tertiary Education (BRIGHT) of the Bulacan State University (BulSU), Regional Higher Education Institutions - III Local and International Network Keystones (RHEI-III LINK) of the Tarlac State University (TSU) and Linkages Around The World Amidst COVID-19 Pandemic (LAWAC) of the Nueva Ecija University of Science and Technology (NEUST). As mentioned in CHEDRO-III Memorandum No. 127 dated 15 September 2021, the implementation of the three (3) PaGITAn projects involves the conduct of surveys, webinars and virtual training and workshops from September to November 2021 to realize the target outputs of each PaGITAn project.

In view of this, the CHEDRO-III requests all public and private HEIs in Region III to accomplish the needs assessment survey through the link: https://forms.gle/7kxUaouS1LBT3vJ99 on or before 24 September 2021.

The data that will be gathered from the survey will be used by the RHEI-III-LINK Technical Working Committee to identify the needs of higher education for international partnership and collaboration that will aid in the attainment of the following major final outputs: (1) Report on the Needs Assessment for Internationalization in Central Luzon towards HEIs' International Partnership and Collaboration, (2) HEIs' Institutional Internationalization and Glocalization Development Plan, (3) Regional Internationalization and Glocalization Development Plan on International Partnership and Collaboration of Central Luzon and (4) Formed Partnership/Consortium among HEIs in Region III and International Partners.
