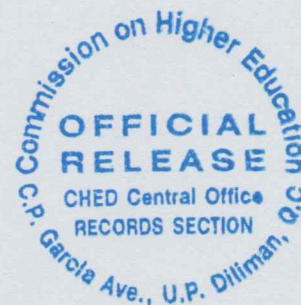



In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722, otherwise known as the *Higher Education Act of 1994*, and in support of Executive Order (EO) No. 66, series of 2018 or the *Institutionalizing the implementation of the Philippine Anti-Illegal Drugs Strategy or PADS*, the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) in partnership with the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) and the ASEAN Training Center for Preventive Drug Education (ATCPDE) will hold the first webinar on Best Practices of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) on Drug Education and Prevention Programs on November 19, 2021 (Friday) at 8:30 AM via Zoom.

This will be a series of webinars where HEIs may share their policies, programs, extension, research, and other effective practices and mechanisms on anti-illegal drugs among their peers and communities of practice. It aims to foster knowledge-building among HEI faculty and personnel in creating innovative ideas, identifying and filling knowledge gaps, constructing a supportive network among HEIs and its community; all for the continuous improvement in implementing the Drug Education and Prevention Programs and for the continued efforts to strengthen the anti-illegal drug campaign in the country.
