This Office endorses the Makatao at Maka-Pilipino: #JWDiokno100 Tiktok Competition from January 14 to February 11, 2022, in celebration of the centennial birth anniversary of Ka Pepe Diokno, organized by the Human Rights Violations Victims' Memorial Commission. Using the Tiktok application as the main platform, this competition aims to reach out and engage with various sectors especially the youth, to broaden their knowledge about the struggle for human rights and democracy in the Philippines. The winners will be announced on February 26, 2022, the centennial birth anniversary of Ka Pepe Diokno.

The Human Rights Violations' Victims Memorial Commission (HRVVMC) is a government agency created under RA 10368 for the establishment, restoration, preservation, and conservation of the Memorial/Museum/Compendium in honor of human rights violations victims during the Martial Law era (1972-1986).

Jose W, Diokno, the "Father of Human Rights Advocacy in the Philippines," is a prominent figure in the struggle for democracy during the Marcos Regime. A human rights lawyer and a prominent opposition leader against the Marcos Administration, he became one of the earliest political prisoners upon the declaration of Martial Law in 1972.
