SUBJECT : ANNUAL CLIMATE CHANGE EXPENDITURE TAGGING (CCET) VIRTUAL ORIENTATION

DATE : February 10, 2022

Pursuant to Sec. 41 of Republic Act No. 11639 or the General Appropriations Act for FY 2022, all national government agencies, SUCs and GOCCs shall tag their budgets for the climate change adaptation and mitigation in accordance with the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and Climate Change Commission (CCC) Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2015-01.

The Climate Change Expenditure Tagging (CCET) is the process of the government to monitor, track and report the bureaucracy's climate change programs.

To obtain a better understanding of the CCET as an integral part of the national budget preparation for FY 2023, the CCC and the DBM in coordination with the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will conduct a zonal virtual orientation on the following schedules:

Dates	SUCs in the following Regions
February 22, 2022 (A.M.)	NCR, I, II, III, IV, CAR and MIMAROPA
February 22, 2022 (P.M.)	VI, VII and VIII
February 23, 2022 (A.M.)	IX, X, XI, XII, Caraga and BARRM


