The Commission on Higher Education hereby informs interested parties of the call for applications to the **2022-2023 Canada-ASEAN Scholarships and Educational Exchanges for Development (SEED) program** for students.

The Canada-ASEAN SEED program aims to provide opportunities to students from ASEAN Member States countries to conduct short-term study or research in Canadian post-secondary institutions in areas that contribute to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and poverty reduction in ASEAN Member States. Moreover, this scholarship program is facilitated through institutional collaborations and student agreements between post-secondary institutions in Canada and their partner institutions in ASEAN countries.

The application for the SEED program shall be submitted by the Canadian institution on behalf of the eligible candidates on or before **03 March 2022**. Interested applicants are encouraged to inform their home institution of their intention to apply for the scholarship before the deadline, to provide sufficient ample time for coordination between their home institution and the Canadian institution.
