The Commission on Higher Education is pleased to inform interested parties of the call for applications to The Chevening – Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies (OCIS) Fellowships which will commence in October 2023.

The OCIS Fellowships are aimed at mid-career academics or professionals who are dedicated to the promotion of academic activities which encouraged a more informed understanding of the culture and civilization of Islam and contemporary music societies.

The Fellowship offers a (1) a six-month period of research at OCIS, (2) living expenses for the duration of the fellowship, (3) return economy airfare from the home country to the UK, (4) allowance package for research-related activities, and (5) access to a programme of cultural events and activities organized by Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office and the Chevening Secretariat.

The application period for the OCIS 2023 cycle is open until **01 November 2022**, at 12 midday GMT.
