Subject : **Search for Filipina Achievers in Rural Education Awards 2022**

The Commission on Higher Education-Central Luzon Region (CHED-CLR) endorses the **Search for Filipina Achievers in Rural Education Awards (FLORA) 2022** under the auspices of **Multinational Foundation, Inc. (MFI)** in partnership with **TOWNS Foundation** to recognize and honor women who have made outstanding contributions to rural education. This award is deemed timely as the health crisis brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic and the ensuing lockdowns have caused significant disruptions to education where women have played meritorious services to ensure the continuous delivery of teaching and learning from among the higher education institutions, in all levels of education, here in Central Luzon.

The FLORA 2022 call for nominations is open to all women educators in basic education, technical education and higher education in 4th, 5th, and 6th class municipalities in Luzon Region, which includes Central Luzon. It seeks nominees who are Filipino citizens who have developed and implemented educational innovations responsive to the challenges of the COVID-19 crisis and disruptions in their communities. The reckoning period of the achievements that will be considered for FLORA 2022 is from **March 2020 to June 2022**. A three-stage selection process will be followed to vet each nomination. The FLORA 2022 awardee/s will receive a cash prize of one hundred thousand pesos (PhP 100, 000.00), a trophy and a plaque.
