The Commission on Higher Education-Central Luzon Region (CHED-CLR) endorses the **PAEPI Global Consultative Forum and Seminar Workshop on Genuine Digital Platform and Global Link for Sustainability cum Updating PAEPI Global Strategic Action Plan** scheduled on **October 26-29, 2022** at the **Maritime Academy of Asia and the Pacific (Bataan, Philippines)** with the theme: **“Strengthening Friendships and Sustainability** organized by the **Philippine Association of Extension Program Implementers, Inc.
