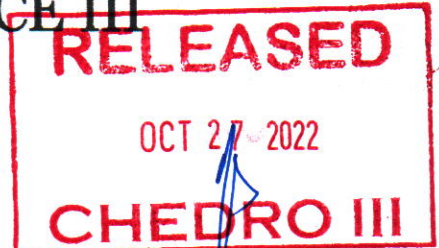

This Office endorses the **Central Luzon Region 1st Education Summit**, with the theme, “**PLAY IT FORWARD: Securing a Sustainable Future**” to be held on **November 11, 2022** at the **University Auditorium, Don Honorio Ventura State University, Bacolor, Pampanga**. This is organized by the **Philippine Institute of Certified Public Accountants (PICPA) Pampanga Chapter**.

The summit aims to upscale the regional state of Accountancy Education and improve the higher education institutions' performance in the licensure examinations.

OBJECTIVE:

To achieve academic excellence in the field of Accountancy and promote camaraderie between and among the participants from different schools in Pampanga.

PARTICIPANTS' QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The PICPA Pampanga Chapter accounting quiz bowl is open to all schools in Pampanga (*excluding those under Angeles Chapter*) offering BS Accountancy, BS Management Accounting and BS Accounting Information System duly recognized as HEIs by CHED
2. All participants are currently enrolled as BS Accountancy, Management Accounting and Accounting Information System students for the 1st semester of AY 2022-2023.
3. For Level 1, participants should be currently 2nd year or 3rd year students who were able to take up Financial Accounting and Reporting, CFAS, Intermediate Accounting 1 & 2 and Accounting for Special Transactions. For level 2, participants should from the graduating class.

The top 3 winners for each level shall become the representative of Pampanga Chapter in the Regional Accounting Quiz.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Each school must send three (3) participant for each level.
2. Certification from the President/Dean stating the names of the contestants as the official representatives of the school. The name of the school shall be clearly indicated in the certification.
3. Change of contestants on the actual day of the event shall only be allowed upon the discretion/decision of the PICPA Chapter President, provided that the circumstance thereof is due to:
 - ✓ an emergency event
 - ✓ sickness/illness (including any symptom of COVID-19) on the event day; and
 - ✓ other valid circumstances deemed to be reasonable

Note: Non-compliance with any of the above-mentioned requirements shall be a ground for disqualification of the contestant.

MECHANICS:

1. The contestant must present their school ID or certification of no ID issued from the school upon registration. Failure to present such may subject the participant to be prohibited from joining the competition.
2. Each contestant is required to bring calculator and pencils. (Programmable calculators are not allowed)
3. Pieces of paper and pentel pens will be provided to the participants during the contest.
4. The contest is composed of three (3) rounds, with 10 questions per round, namely: **Easy**, **Average**, and **Difficult**.
5. Each correct answer under the **Easy** round questions is equivalent to 5 points, The **Average** round, it is 10 points, and for the **Difficult** round, each correct answer is worth 15 points.
6. Each contestant will be given a copy of questions for the round at the same time. The question will be flashed on the widescreen for the audience.
7. The time allotted for each question is as follows: **Easy** round, 15 seconds; **Average** round, 30 seconds; and **Difficult** round, 60 seconds (1 minute).
8. After each round, the answers will be checked and tabulated at once and the result will be announced before the start of the next round. The questions given to the contestants will be read aloud with the corresponding correct answer for the benefit of the contestants and the audience alike.
