Participants from SUCs, LUCs, private HEIs and other stakeholders shall have to make arrangements on their travel expenses with their respective institutions.

Food during the public orientation shall be provided by CHED. To ascertain logistic preparations, only one (1) representative per HEI shall be allowed to attend this activity. CHED Regional Offices are requested to forward confirmations of participants from their respective regions to CHED-Office of Programs and Standard Development not later than five (5) days before the date of public orientations.
