Attached is a copy of the Memorandum from the Office of the Executive Director of UniFAST dated June 01, 2023 reiterating the eligibility to Free Higher Education (FHE) of students already enrolled in SUCs and LUCs during the passage of R.A. No. 10931 and failed to complete their programs within the grace period.

It is emphasized that students who fail to complete their bachelor's degree or comparable undergraduate degree within a year after the prescribed in their program are ineligible to avail FHE.

This is to reiterate the standing administrative interpretation of Section 6 (a) (3) of R.A. No. 10931, which reads:

"Section 6. Exceptions to Free Tertiary Education. - The following students are ineligible to avail of the free tertiary education:

(a) In SUCs and LUCs:

(3) Students who fail to complete their bachelor's degree or comparable undergraduate degree within a year after the period prescribed in their program..."

. As conveyed to the Secretariat by the Office of the Solicitor General on May 27, 2019, students already enrolled in State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and CHED-recognized Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) during the passage of Republic Act No. 10931, but who fail to complete their programs within a year after the period prescribed for their program are ineligible for Free Higher Education. This view is in consonance with the plain meaning or verba legis rule, which states that when a statute is clear, plain and free from ambiguity, it must be given its literal meaning and applied without attempted interpretation.

The disqualification under Section 6(a)(3) was intended to apply to all Filipino students, whether the student enrolled in the program before or after the effectivity of R.A. No. 10931.

Further, the Secretariat would like to add that the foregoing is consistent with the principle that the provisions of said law shall be understood to favor deserving students and optimized utilization of government resources in education.

This reiteration is being issued to remind old personnel and inform new ones of this existing policy. All are exhorted to disseminate this Memorandum to the SUCs and LUCs under your CHEDRO's jurisdiction. Thank you.
