GIANT LANTERN FESTIVAL 2023 INTER-SCHOOL LANTERN PARADE COMPETITION

Theme : "Batuin Fernandino, Aslag ning Pag-Asa" December 1, 2023 (Friday)



MECHANICS:

The following are the mechanics to be followed for inter-school lantern competition.

- 1. Participants are expected to be at the venue exactly 4:00 PM at the Mini Convention Center, Heroes Hall.
- 2. The parade will start at exactly 5:00 PM.
- 3. Participants will only be allowed to use INDIGENOUS and RECYCLABLE MATERIALS in their lantern and must be EASILY LIGHTED AND HUNG.
 - a. The lantern must be 5ft. in diameter and 5ft. in height, excluding the stand.
 - Must be made of discarded or used recyclable materials (paper, magazine, cardboard, scraps of fabrics, MRF bottles, bottle caps, etc) or indigenous or native materials (leaves, twigs, seeds, shells, bamboo, etc).
 - c. Materials should be 70% indigenous/Recyclables and 30% commercial.
 - d. Violation/s in any form in the aforementioned mechanics means 5 points deduction per violation.
 - e. Must be **lighted with light bulbs with its own power source** (car battery), but should also be ready to be plugged to an electrical outlet. Please use "kariton or tri-wheel bike" to carry the batteries of the lantern.
 - f. Students are to parade in their *lubenas* (2ft. in diameter) entry in relevance to the theme "Batuin Fernandino, Aslag ning Pag-Asa"
- 4. A minimum of 12 and a maximum of 20 students per school can participate in the parade. Advance copy of registration form will be provided by the secretariat.
- 5. The lanterns will be judged after the parade and judges' decision is final.
- 6. Lanterns will be displayed at the Robinsons Starmills after the competition for possible auction purposes; proceeds of the auction will be given to the respective school.
- 7. There will be 3 categories:
 - ELEMENTARY (K-6)
 - HIGH SCHOOL (7-12)
 - COLLEGE
- 8. All participating schools will receive a subsidy amounting to P 5,000.00.
- 9. Cash prizes per category is as follows:
