The Commission on Higher Education hereby informs all interested parties of the call for applications to the MAEC-AECID Scholarships for citizens of countries in Latin America, Africa and Asia 2024-2025.

This call is part of the initiatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, European Union and Cooperation of Spain, through the Spanish Agency for International Development Cooperation (AECID), that aims at promoting the training of human capital, strengthening the individual capacities of those interested, as well as the institutions of origin.

You may refer to the three programs below where you can apply for:

1. Master Program is a scholarship to take a face-to-face master's degree in Spain for public employees and personnel integrated in the public systems of Latin American countries and the Philippines.

-Master Spanish Philippines is a scholarship grant for Filipino teachers from public universities or educational centers in their country to study in a Spanish university for a master's degree of a maximum of 60 ECTS credits in Spain, related to the teaching of Spanish as a foreign language.

2. Diplomatic School Program is a scholarship for citizens from Latin America, Africa, the Middle East and the Philippines to take the Inter-University Master's Degree in Diplomacy and International Relations at the Spanish Diplomatic School.

3. ASALE Program is a scholarship for the Master's Degree in Hispanic Lexicography and Linguistic Correction in Spain and collaborative training stays at the headquarters of the Spanish Language Academies associated with the Royal Spanish Academy (RAE), for citizens from Latin

America, the United States of America, Equatorial Guinea and the Philippines.
