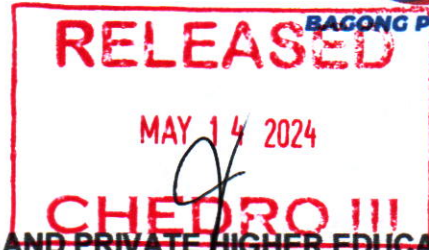

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LIGLIGANG POESYANG MAKUYAD GUIDELINES

1. Filipino and Kapampangan are the two (2) languages to be used in the Ligligang Poesyang Makuyad.
2. As students might be unfamiliar with the traditional forms of dyona, tanaga, and dalit; thus, they are encouraged to participate in a two-day workshop-seminar on May 23 (Filipino) or May 24 (Kapampangan) to learn about the forms. Following the sessions, they will compose original poems to be submitted as contest entries.
3. Each contestant will submit three (3) poems for each form.
4. The criteria for judging the entries will be:

○ Artistic sensibility	-	70 %
○ Structural coherence	-	15 %
○ Linguistic proficiency	-	15 %
Total	-	100 %
5. First-, second-, and third-place winners will be selected from each language's categories.
6. The cash prizes for each division (i.e., Filipino and Kapampangan) will be as follows subject to government taxes (13% for honoraria, 20% for prizes):

○ First Prize	-	Php 3,500.00
○ Second Prize	-	Php 3,000.00
○ Third Prize	-	Php 2,000.00
○ Consolation Prizes (6)	-	Php 1,000.00
