This Office endorses the conduct of the **three-day webinar** entitled, “**Transforming Instructions to Cultivate Creativity with MATATAG Learning Competencies**” which is set on **September 19-20, 2024** via **Zoom** and **Facebook Live**, organized by the **College of Education of Tarlac Agricultural University (TAU)**, a designated **Center of Excellence in Teacher Education** by the Commission.

This School Year 2024-2025 saw the implementation of the MATATAG curriculum by the Department of Education. This shift in the basic education landscape is set to create a significant ripple effect that will present an impact on the curricular designs of teacher education programs in the country. As such, this will require instructors and professors in the Teacher Education Institutions (TEIs) to reassess and reimagine their approaches and teaching practices through the integration of the MATATAG curriculum into their course syllabi.

In view of the above, the College of Education of TAU conceptualized this webinar to equip the faculty members of TEIs in the Region with the necessary information on the integration of the MATATAG learning outcomes into the curricular designs of various teacher education programs. Specifically, said webinar aims to:

1. Identify and classify the learning competencies from the MATATAG curriculum;
2. Analyze the MATATAG learning competencies by identifying the opportunities that will improve and align the current teacher education curricular program/s; and
3. Revisit the problem-based and project-based approaches for the MATATAG curriculum.
