- Font Style and Size: **Times New Roman 12 pt**
- Spacing: **Single**
- Margins: **1 inch on all sides**
- Alignment: **Justified**
- The title is **centered** and in **Boldface**.
- Name/s of author/s affiliation and email address/es are **centered**.
- The main body of the abstract is limited to **250 words** and is divided into: **College introduction** (background/objective), **method**, **results** (interpretation/discussions) and **conclusion**.
- **Keywords** should be indicated in the bottom in **italics**.
- Download the abstract template indicated in the caption.
- Submit your abstract in a **.pdf** format to the email account of PCMS reflected in the caption.
- Deadline of submission will be on **October 1, 2024**.
- Submitted abstracts will undergo screening by the research reviewers. The qualified abstracts will be notified via email.
