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**“Climate Change x Sustainable Development: Reflections to Move Forward”**  
Webinar Details

**I. Overview**

LINANGAN's next webinar on disaster risk management will feature the pedagogy of GE courses *STS 1: Science, Technology, and Society* and *Geog 1: Places and Landscapes in a Changing World*. The webinar aims to highlight how these two GE courses nurture environmental consciousness and introduce sustainable development among students in the advent of climate change that is social and political as much as it is natural. Participants are expected to gain knowledge and insights on how they can encourage students to rediscover their relationship with nature, develop critical stances on how and why disasters happen, and craft innovative ways to take care of the environment.

**II. Some Questions for Discussion**

1. How do STS 1 and Geog 1 teach scientific facts in a way that leads to participatory development as students foster a greater understanding of climate change and reflect on ways to rectify destructive anthropogenic practices?
2. How can STS 1 inspire proclivity to sustainable innovations by redefining technological advancements as *made with* the environment rather than solely *made by* humans?
3. How does Geog 1 discuss climate change in the context of a *changing* world, wherein societies of different cultures, politics, and histories converge and diverge?
