In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", CHED Regional Office III shall conduct an Executive Session with LUC Presidents and Vice President for Academic Affairs on Tuesday, January 21, 2025, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, venue of which is to be announced later.
