In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", CHED Regional Office III shall conduct an Executive Session with the SUC Presidents, Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs and MIS Directors on Thursday, January 30, 2025, from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, at the Best Western Plus Metro Clark, Saver's Building, Mc Arthur Highway, Balibago, Angeles City.

This session is designed exclusively for the Presidents/Heads/Officers-in-Charge, Vice Presidents for Academic Affairs and MIS Directors of SUCs in the Region. Hence, representatives will not be allowed.

The executive session aims to:

1. Present status of programs with and without COPCs;

2. Discuss the conversion of RRPA issued to SUCs into Certificates of Program Compliance (COPC);

3. Present joint CHED-PRC agreement on COPCs;

4. Provide timeline for 100% compliance;

5. Present findings on SUC submission of higher education data; and

6. Harmonize registry of program offerings.
