EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (HEIs)

Pursuant to pertinent provisions of Republic Act (R.A.) 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994" and by virtue of Republic Act No. 11285 (Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act) and the Administrative Order (A.O.) No. 110 series of 2004, the national government recognizes the need to intensify energy conservation efforts and promote efficient utilization thereof. Likewise, the Inter-Agency Energy Efficiency and Conservation Committee (IAEECC) Resolution No. 5, s. 2022 directs all government entities to observe the approved Government Energy Management Program (GEMP) Guidelines. Furthermore, the A.O. No. 15 series of 2024, calls for the acceleration of the implementation of the GEMP through energy audits, institutionalization of energy efficiency and conservation (EEC) measures, and compliance with relevant DOE guidelines, among others.

In line with this, a survey on GEMP compliance among public Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) was disseminated through MOED No. 51, series of 2025 dated January 21, 2025, which aimed to identify best practices, gaps, and areas for improvement in energy conservation efforts. However, there were public HEIs that were not able to respond on the said survey.

In view of the foregoing and in line with the CHED's commitment to fostering good governance, the survey on GEMP compliance among public Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) is re-opened. All State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) and Local Universities and Colleges (LUCs) are requested to accomplish the survey **on or before April 11, 2025**, which can be accessed through this link: <https://bit.ly/GEMPSurvey>. SUCs/LUCs that completed the survey in January 2025 need not retake it unless the compliance of the institution has changed or progressed since then.

Wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
